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John Duval Wines, Barossa Valley, AUS

John Duval is one of the world's best known winemakers, saluted many times on the world stage, notably International Winemaker of the Year 1989 and twice Red Winemaker of the Year in 1991 and 2000. Toward the end of 2002, John retired from Southcorp after a distinguished career of 28 years, including 16 years as Chief Winemaker for Penfolds. John embarked on the development of his own label in 2003 using old vine Barossa Valley fruit and has created three stunning wines that reflect the terroir of the Barossa and the hand crafted attention of John Duval.

2008 John Duval Plexus Shiraz Grenache Mourvedre - \$49.99

The aim with Plexus is to express the wide spectrum of red fruit flavours from Shiraz, Grenache and Mourvedre, but also provide structure with a seamless balance and long finish. A low percentage of new oak, adds complexity rather than dominate the berry fruit. Traditional, low intervention winemaking techniques are employed with Plexus, allowing the wine to be approachable in it's youth, but also have great potential for improvement in the bottle under good cellaring conditions for at least 8-10 years.

2008 John Duval Entity Shiraz - \$54.99

My aim with Entity is to produce a wine true to the Barossa. The 2008 vintage started with favourable flowering conditions, a nice surprise after the 2007 drought year. After a few hot days in December, January and February were relatively mild with excellent conditions for ripening. My vintage started with Shiraz from the Krondorf region on the 5th of February, four days earlier than 2007. By the end of February I had all of my best Shiraz blocks harvested, which proved to be good timing to avoid the heat wave experienced in Southern Australia in early March.

My vintage started with Shiraz from the Krondorf region on the 5th of February, four days earlier than 2007. Shoofly Wines, South Australia

The Shoofly winemaking team is led by one of Australia's best – Ben Riggs. As a native of McLaren Vale, he has been crafting some of the region's finest for two decades. His vision is clear: no flabby wines, no raisins and leave the oak for the trees! The team brings decades of winemaking and tasting experience to the table, so they've figured out how to make a wine that will drink well to the last drop. These are fleshy, balanced wines bursting with vibrant, delicious fruit, unlike some of the jammy, soupy, 'dead fruit' styles that have found their way onto the shelves of late.

2011 Frisk Prickly Riesling, Victoria AUS - \$14.99

It's a mouth-revving, lively Riesling that's light on its feet. You may detect notes of lemon sorbet, bath salts and white lilies layered with spices from your favorite childhood pie shop... guess that depends on your childhood. But you can't deny its raciness and versatility, sidling up suggestively to food that's both sweet and spicy. Its intensity will slap you in the face, the oodles of length will have you scrambling for more.

2008 Shoofly The Freckle, South Australia - \$16.99

We had a yearning for the classic (well in the Rhone anyway) combination of Marsanne, Roussanne and Viognier. Knowing one of our Langhorne McLaren Vale growers had a small patch of mature Marsanne and the famously 'freckly' Roussanne in his midst, we went straight to the source and snared all he had. The result is a wine that takes you on a stroll through a summer orchard with aromas of peaches, white nectarines and spices leaping from the glass.

2008 Shoofly Buzzcut, South Australia - \$16.99

A wildly aromatic blend of Verdelho, Viognier, Sauvignon Blanc, Riesling, Chardonnay and Semillon. The fruit is sourced from McLaren Vale, Adelaide Hills and Langhorne Creek, fermented in stainless steel and bottled fresh and young for immediate enjoyment. It's a lush blend showing juicy, tropical flavors, exotic perfume and a refreshing, structured palate.

2010 Shoofly Shiraz, McLaren Vale/Langhorne Creek - \$19.99

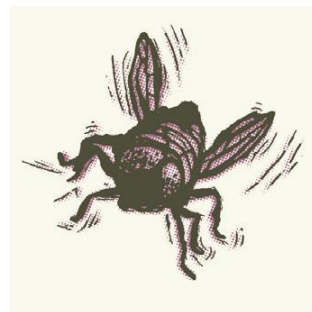

Big, bold and delicious fruit flavors with oodles of spicy plums, black pepper and earthy mint. It's a succulent thunderbolt of pure Shiraz.

2007 Shoofly Aussie Salute, Langhorne Creek/Fleurieu Penn. - \$19.99

Predominantly Shiraz and Grenache with a splash of Viognier, all from Langhorne Creek on the Fleurieu Peninsula. The fruit is tank fermented then spends 8 months in new and older American and French oak for an enticing fusion of aromatic spice and vanilla. This feisty combination reeks of ripe blackberry, plum and currant notes, offers plenty of structure and grip and lingers with a "have another glass" finish.

THE ADVENTURE CONTINUES

Baillie-Grohman Estate Winery – Creston, BC

Our winery is named after one of our region's most legendary pioneers, William Baillie-Grohman, as his pioneering, tenacious spirit is one we admire. We are on the edge of an emerging wine-growing area, in a unique microclimate in the Kootenay district of British Columbia, in a community called Creston. It is exciting to explore this region, like Baillie-Grohman did, but in our case we are uncovering characteristics that yield wines with new fingerprints not seen before in the world of wine.

Our approach is to produce small lots of super premium wine in our 5,000 case boutique winery. Everything is done by hand, from the farming to picking and sorting at harvest. Grape production is maintained at a low yield, with the aspiration of quality and concentrated flavours.

2009 Baillie-Grohman Gewurtztraminer VQA- \$17.99 – NEW PRICE! SPEC 125344

The 2009 Gewürztraminer is straw with a green hue in colour, and aromas of lifted notes of rose petal, exotic spices, musk and ripe sweet fruit. The palate is rich with a long finish and great balance displaying notes of Turkish delight, wildflowers, lychee and perfume.

2010 Baillie-Grohman Pinot Gris VQA- \$21.99 SPEC 128298

The 2010 Pinot Gris offers up aromas of lifted citrus, with green apple and a hint of mango all followed by notes summer rain on hot limestone. A medium bodied palate, with a great oily texture from partial barrel fermentation, with hints of smokey, yeasty notes and a little oak in the profile. Notes of Lemon meringue pie with punchy lime and green apple with hints of cardamon. Great structure, supple when young, yet will reward with cellaring.

2009 Baillie-Grohman Chardonnay VQA- \$26.99 SPEC 386664

The 2009 Chardonnay is a pale straw colour with a green hue, and a nose of citrus with white flowers and melon. The palate is textural with a long finish displaying notes of stone fruit, melon and a concentrated minerality

2010 Baillie-Grohman Blanc de Noirs VQA- \$17.99 – NEW PRICE! SPEC 672584

The 2010 Blanc de Noirs is a pretty rose petal pink with a salmon hue; with lifted notes of strawberry, wild raspberry, cassis and cranberry on the nose. The rich textural palate offers strawberry, sweet red berry, cranberry and rhubarb . The finish is long and balanced.

2009 Baillie-Grohman Pinot Noir VQA- \$24.99 SPEC 125336

The 2009 Estate Pinot Noir is a deep cherry colour with a ruby hue. The style is fruit driven, displaying spicy berry and concentrated red fruit characters, with notes of mushroom, red currant aromas and beetroot. On the palate it is a soft, medium bodied wine with elegant fruit and gentle tannins and smooth finish.

2009 Baillie-Grohman Reserve Pinot Noir VQA- \$35.99 SPEC 125328

The Reserve Pinot Noir is still in barrels maturing and we will keep its progress posted here. Notes from the barrel samples are...slurrpp.....mmmmm.....aaahhhh..... still not released.

Vina Koyle - Colchagua, Chile

In 1885 Don Francisco Undurruga, became a pioneer by making superior wines from the best Chilean vineyards. The Undurruga family has since then been dedicated to producing great Chilean wines for six generations. Today this family tradition continues with Viña Koyle. The wines come from a unique terroir in Alto Colchagua which borders with the Andes Mountains. Viña Koyle is the result of the family's unending quest for excellence and has a strong terroir orientation, therefore only producing high quality reserve red wines.

2009 Vina Koyle Syrah Reserva - \$16.99

Koyle Reserva Syrah, is an elegant wine with a very well defined character. It comes from carefully selected grapes, manually harvested in the valleys of Maipo and Colchagua. In these valleys, we look for areas with a strong oceanic influence, that provide a fresh and intense character.

Koyle Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon is a concentrated and well balanced wine, made with grapes from different areas in Chile. Our Koyle Syrah is the full expression of the variety, coming from the French clone 300, who mixed with the terroir characteristics show aromas of fresh meat and blackcherry, and a nice hint of graphite notes at the final. The blend in this wine have a 11% of Malbec, who help to exalt the elegance of the wine, and a 4% Carmenère who give complexity to the final. **90 Points – Wine Enthusiast**

2008 Vina Koyle Royale Cabernet Sauvignon - \$26.99

Terrapura Winery, Chile

2010 Terrapura Chardonnay, Curico, Chile - \$10.99

It has a light yellow color, with delicate aromas of mandarin, apple as well as tropical fruits and a touch of vanilla. On the palate it is fresh and round with honey notes finishing with a fresh acidity. It is the perfect accompaniment for salads, cheeses, pastas and fish.

2010 Terrapura Carmenere, Colchagua, Chile - \$10.99

Profound and expressive aromas, with notes of strawberries, cherries and a touch of pepper. On the palate it is silky, with sweet tannins and a long finish. It is the perfect partner for a broad range of dishes such as fish, pastas and both red and white meats.

Casa del Bosque - Casablanca, Chile

Casas del Bosque is located 70 km from Santiago, the capital of Chile, and 30 km from one of the principal ports of Chile, Valparaiso. It was conceived in 1993 to be a family boutique winery exclusively oriented to the production of high quality wines. Casas del Bosque has its own vineyards in the Casablanca Valley, a privileged place for premium wine production. It guarantees that our entire grape production and all its treatment is carefully handled and controlled by us, leading to the highest quality.

2010 Casa del Bosque Sauvignon Blanc Reserva - \$16.99

All fruit was sourced from our own vineyard - located within the coolest, westernmost reaches of the Casablanca Valley. Intense notes of lime and grapefruit dominate on the nose leading to pure flavors of nectarine and white peach in the mouth. A bright, zesty acidity imparts excellent structure and length.

Matetic Vineyards – San Antonio, Chile

The story of the Matetic Winery begins in 1999 when the Matetic family decided to diversify their business ventures and enter the world of wine, confident in the virtues of the climate and soils in the Rosario Valley. With a firm conviction in the vital importance of maintaining a strong professional team to guide every step of the project, the family incorporated Alan York (Biodinamic Consultant), Ken Bernards (Consulting Winemaker), and Ann Kraemer (Viticultural Consultant) into the project in 2000 to ensure that Matetic wines achieve the highest quality.

Matetic EQ Sauvignon Blanc, San Antonio Valley - \$24.99

This clone 242 Sauvignon Blanc is planted on north-facing slopes at 1.5 x 2.2 m. on shallow red soils that turn to decomposing rock at 35 cm below the surface. Intense canopy management and deficit irrigation maintains yields at 1.8 kg/plant. Vinification took place in 5,000-liter stainless steel tanks with 25% fermented in year-old French oak barrels. This is a Sauvignon Blanc with great distinction and aromatic notes of warm fruits such as melon and papaya. Soft citrus aromas add a fresh, youthful touch. The palate is structured with vibrant acidity and very well accompanied by subtle contributions of the wood for a harmoniously intertwined combination of freshness and elegance on the long, long finish.

Matetic EQ Pinot Noir, San Antonio Valley - \$42.99

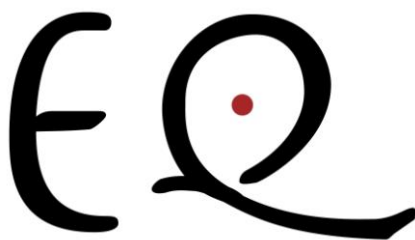
The grapes used in this wine come from three different plots, all planted on primarily-north-facing slopes with poor, deep red soils with clay on the surface (40 cm) and decomposing rock below. Vineyards are planted 1.2 x 2.2 m with clonal selections 777, 115, and Valdivieso. Each clone was vinified separately in open tanks. Following a 5-day cold maceration, fermentation took place with specially-selected yeasts, and varied pump-over techniques were used to develop the specific qualities of each of the individual clones. The resulting wine was then aged for 11 months in French oak barrels.

Matetic EQ Syrah, San Antonio Valley - \$ 42.99

The grapes for this 2002 Syrah are grown in a flat, north-facing sector with poor clay-loam-lime soils. Clones 174 and 300 are planted 2x 2.2m for low yield and high quality. Foliage is intensively managed and vigor is reduced with specific crops planted between the rows along with deficit irrigation, resulting in yields of 1.4-1.6 kg /plant. The wine was then aged for 13 months in first-use French oak barrels. The intensely-colored wine is almost black with a purplish rim. It has great aromatic complexity, with marked notes of black and white pepper and native forest, along with intense violet floral notes. Elegantly structured with velvety, ripe and well-rounded tannins, it explodes on the palate, clearly demonstrating its force and concentration.





Vignobles Alain Maurel – Cabardès, France

Alain Maurel started in the AOC Cabardès in 1973. This winery from the unique Cabardès region stands out by showcasing an innovative and unique range of products. The Cabardès vineyard lies in the foothills of the Massif Central, called the black mountain, 10 km from Carcassonne. Cabardès is one of the most reputed viticultural terroirs of the Languedoc Roussillon, both for the high quality of its wines and their originality. (Alain Maurel Vineyards is CABARDÈS' 2nd largest producer in volume).



Domaine Ventenac, Vin de Pays

2008 Domaine Ventenac Chenin Colombard – Vin de Pays - \$16.99 **SPEC** **150433**

This is a wine that sets out to break away from the Languedoc 'standards' by delivering a wine that is focused, bright, fresh and fruity. Demonstrates explosive primary aromas of grapefruit and lemon, showing focused structure, balance and complexity on the finish.

2008 Domaine Ventenac Chardonnay – Vin de Pays - \$16.99 **SPEC** **95547**

Reduced yields per vine help to show minerality and focus coupled with aromatic complexity and balanced structure on the palate. Exotic fruits, honey and slightly toasted notes demonstrate the style of this Chardonnay

2008 Domaine Ventenac Rose – Vin de Pays - \$16.99 **SPEC** **664052**

Domaine Ventenac Syrah – Vin de Pays - \$16.99 **SPEC** **850842**

The idea of vinifying Syrah as a single varietal was decided upon after realizing the aromatic potential of the Syrah planted in the high slopes on layers of particularly rocky white Limestone. This fruit, which is not used in the AOC blend, is much more Northern Rhone style showing more pepper and strong concentration of violet.



Chateau Ventenac, AOC Cabardès

Chateau Ventenac Reserve Cabardès - \$19.99 **SPEC** **543637**

The Cabardès blend must contain a min 40% of the Atlantic varietals (Cabernet and Merlot) and 40% of the Mediterranean varietals but varies vintage to vintage. The Chateau Ventenac Reserve is a fresh expression of this terroir, showing intense aromas of red fruits heightened by spicier scents.

Chateau Ventenac Grande Reserve Cabardès - \$24.99 **SPEC** **140376**

The Grand Reserve is made in the same philosophy as the Reserve but differs mainly by the ageing regimen, 100% of the wine is aged in oak (1/3 one year old, 1/3 two year old, 1/3 three year old). The result is a structured wine with soft, round tannins and more up front toasted and vanilla notes which will cellar nicely over time.

OGIO is an exciting new brand that is putting energy into the Italian wine category in countries around the world. Sourced from the Veneto region of Italy, OGIO wines are styled to be fresh, modern and consumer friendly. Sleek, modern packaging helps to bring the brand together as a contemporary take on a classic wine style and category

OGIO Pinot Grigio – Veneto, Italy - \$10.99

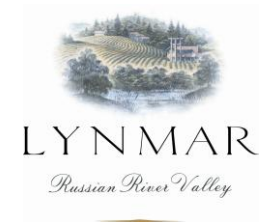
A crisp, dry white wine with fresh lemon and lime flavors together with a delicious hint of orange blossom. Beautiful balance of fruit and acidity makes this wine a remarkable value!

OGIO Primitivo – Apulia, Italy - \$12.99

A deeply colored wine packed full of cherry, clove and chocolate flavors. The grapes are manually harvested in September and gently crushed. They are fermented in stainless steel tanks for 6-8 days at a temperature between 24-28C. After fermentation the wine is aged in traditional large oak casks to allow further integration and balance.



Lynmar Estate – Russian River Valley, Sonoma

LYNMAR ESTATE is a producer of highest quality and limited-quantity Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Sonoma County’s Russian River Valley. In alignment with the philosophy of the proprietor, Lynn Fritz, the wines from Lynmar Estate are elegant, perfectly balanced, complex expressions of their origin and should be appreciated by the most discriminating consumers.

Lynmar Estate Chardonnay – Russian River - \$44.99

Aromas of apple pie blend with lemon meringue, fresh pear and apple blossom, lightly scented with a touch of toast, brioche and hazelnut. The palate is richly layered with beautiful fruit intensity, good structure and firm acidic grip. Will stand up to 2 -3 years of aging in cellar

Lynmar Estate Pinot Noir – Russian River - \$49.99

This outstanding vintage gives an immediate impression of depth and concentration in the glass. The palate is clearly fruit driven showing a pronounced sense of balance offering firm structure and lovely concentration. Tannins are perfectly ripe, adding structure and grip to a framework that will allow this wine to age well (now - 2014/16)





Purple Cowboy Wines – Paso Robles, CA - September 2010

The Purple Cowboy wines are the brainchild of the Canopy Management wine company and Co—founder Terry Wheatley. She launched a little idea called Tough Enough To Wear Pink five years ago this year. \$ 1.00 from every case of Purple Cowboy wines sold goes to support Tough Enough to Wear Pink which helps in the fight against Breast Cancer. The grapes for Purple Cowboy come for the most part from Paso Robles, the largest AVA in San Luis Obispo County on California’s famed Central Coast. Over the years, Paso Robles was known for producing structured Cabernet Sauvignon, in more recent times a group of winemakers known as the Rhone Rangers has garnered attention with Syrah, a grape well-suited to this warm region.

Purple Cowboy Tenacious Red – Paso Robles, CA - \$17.99 **SPECIALTY** **136960**

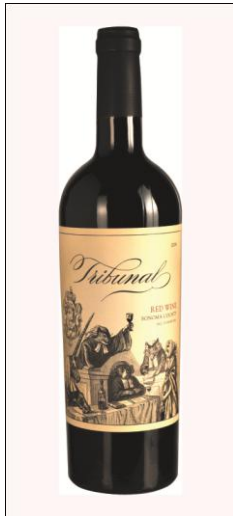

Lot 212 hails from one of the most prestigious producers from Carneros. This producer has incredible vineyard management and a top of the line crush facility. They focus on more Burgundian varietals, really utilizing the cooler climate of Carneros. Their overall knowledge of the cool-climate varietals gives these guys the ability to put out top-notch Chardonnay with just enough excess to give us a lot or two! If you like cool-climate Chardonnay with Napa influence, this Chardonnay is for you.

2009 Lot 273 Chardonnay, Arroyo Seco, CA - \$20.99 **SPEC** **194308**

Arroyo Seco is one of the best places in California to grow Chardonnay. This vineyard has been growing Chardonnay since the 1960's. Planted to three Dijon clones and two proprietary clones, this vineyard boasts a line of grapes originally selected for it's intense varietal character and low yield. The cool growing season and the deep gravelly soil ripen the Chardonnay perfectly, creating a natural balance of sugar and acidity.

2009 Lot 215 Chardonnay, Willamette Valley, OR - \$23.99 **SPEC** **620906**

This wine is brought to us by the same grower group that produced our recent Pinot Noir and Napa Merlot releases. Lot 215 2009 Willamette Valley Chardonnay comes from the northern end of the Eola-Amity Hills regions, home to many of Oregon's finest Pinot Noir grapes. The cool-climate, combined with shallow, well-drained volcanic soils, is IDEAL for both Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Lot 215 is all done in stainless steel with a partial malolactic fermentation to soften some of the acidity and round out the mouth feel of the wine.

2008 Lot 173 Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma, CA - \$21.99 **SPECIALTY** **224162**

This wine comprises 82% Cabernet Sauvignon from Alexander Valley and 10% Chalk Hill Cabernet, with a little Malbec and Carignane to round out the blend. The wines are sourced from multiple boutique wineries located in the Alexander Valley.

2009 Lot 244 California Field Blend California - \$22.99 **SPECIALTY** **435131**

The wines we sourced from this deal make up a considerable part of the repositioning of a particular ultra-premium Zinfandel and Zin-based blend producer that was sold a year or so ago. As part of the deal one of the brands was discontinued altogether and we purchased all of those wines and others from the flagship brand as they sought to maintain the over \$35/bottle price point by reducing inventory. This is a classic deal for Cameron Hughes Wine but it's also a one-time deal as they severely cut back the 2010 contracts so grab what you can of these incredible values.

2009 Lot 219 Zinfandel, Monte Rosso Vnyrd, Sonoma, CA - \$34.99 **SPECIALTY** **190165**

Lot 219 hails from the slopes of Monte Rosso, the oldest continuously operated vineyard in California. These guys are some of the most famous pioneers of Zinfandel vineyards and have been doing Zin for a long time. This wine comes from a 40 dollar bottle program boasting 25% new America and French oak. This wine was barrel-aged for a year, and is just baby right now, decant for best result.

2009 Lot 241 SGM, Arroyo Secco, CA - \$24.99 **SPEC** **194316**

Sourced from an excellent winery in Arroyo Seco, this bottle comes from a \$30 dollar bottle program that we hope to have the opportunity to source from again. We're currently looking at their 2010 vintage and have been really impressed with the complexity of their wines and winegrowing skills. These guys have been making wine since the early seventies and are pioneers of great California wines.

2009 Lot 249 Meritage, Alexander Valley, CA - \$24.99

This wine is sourced from choice vineyards in the hillsides of Alexander Valley just east of Geyserville, where some of the most revered Cabernets in California are grown. This wine was blended with other beautiful parcels of Cab Franc, Cab Sauv, and Petite Verdot and let age even longer. The bottom line on this wine folks is that it comes from one of the best kept secrets in Northern California, gorgeous hillside Alexander vineyards boasting Rutherford-class dirt at 700ft elevation reinforced with great blending pieces from Dry Creek. If you like classic Bordeaux blends with high-toned California styling, pick this wine up now.

2008 Lot 208 Cabernet Sauvignon/Syrah, Napa, CA - \$24.99

With a few of the other wines that we have been releasing recently, this wine came from the recently closed Havens Wine Cellars. Havens Winery, located just south of Yountville, was a short, quiet drive off Highway 29, Napa Valley's main winery tour route. Havens had earned distinction for its Merlot, Syrah, and other red blends before being sold off. This wine in particular was one of their most notable productions. The Cabernet and Syrah grapes were co-fermented in top-of-the-line equipment to create what was known as Havens 'Black and Blue.' With 50% Cabernet and 50% Syrah, this wine is one of the most interesting and structured blends that we've seen from Havens. **Wine Access Value Wine Awards – Category Winner – Red Blends**

2008 Lot 211 Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, CA - \$28.99

This wine is a reserve program Cab from a famous Napa producer. This wine is a super classic Napa Cabernet with rich fruit and structure. Mostly Valley fruit coming from primarily Oakville and Rutherford. These guys have been making great wine since the early seventies and will continue to put out killer Cab, let's all hope we will see more of this in the Lot Series. Expect to pay \$40-50 or more under the original program.

2008 Lot 218 Cabernet Sauvignon, Rutherford, Napa, CA - \$29.99

There is no doubt is the best Rutherford Cabernet we have ever produced. Its sourced from an ultra-premium program and is CLASSIC Rutherford Cabernet replete with the trademark Rutherford Dust both aromatically and on the palate. The fruit for this wine is all sourced from the legendary Georges III Vineyard in Rutherford and the wines routinely score 90-92 points from the Wine Spectator. We have bought wine from this program before but never first run juice like this. Bottled late 2010, this wine will continue to gain complexity in the bottle over the next 8 months before settling in for more consistent aging.

2008 Lot 188 Cabernet, Chalk Hill Sonoma, CA - \$29.99

This is one of a few Chalk Hill Cabs that are sourced from one of the most beautiful vineyards I have ever seen (grapes always seem to grow best in beautiful places). This wine is our 3rd and best vintage to come out of this grower/winery. It's huge—spanning more than 500 acres, several hundred of which are planted to grapes and almost all of which are hillside with little nooks and crannies that create a variety of microclimates. The vineyard is the source of many different grape varieties for something like 20 small, ultra-premium brands (though we control all the Cabernet off the vineyard). The winery that was previously buying the fruit was putting it into its \$60 Cabernet.

2008 Lot 189 Cabernet Sauvignon, Stag's Leap, CA - \$39.99

What really gives Stags Leap its terroir is the cool evening breezes from the San Pablo bay and rocky volcanic soils. Combined with the eastern exposure, this is an ideal place for growing grapes. The oak on this wine comes from great cooperage—some new French oak, some old—and it really shows. At the end of the day, folks, this may be the best Stags Leap Cab that we've put out and an extraordinary value at that.

Lot 278 represents the great diversity of the Spring Mountain District. The wine hails from a rather famous vineyard up on Spring Mountain that has been in what is pretty much a perpetual state of development since the 1960's. Luckily the 2008 vintage (as well the 2009) were both just about as good as it gets from the site.

2002 Lot 263 Gran Reserva Ribera del Duero Tempranillo - \$49.99

For a wine that has spent 3 years in barrel and almost 6 years in the bottle, it's remarkably deeply hued. That said, the historical reasons for the Spaniards cave ageing their wines for so long really have to do with their tannin structures – the wines were typically hard edged and needed time in the cellar to soften. Sourced from 40 to 80 year old vines, the wine undergoes 40 days of maceration before undergoing a hot, fast fermentation to maximize aromatics before going down to barrel for 36 months of ageing in oak. Now, to answer your question – how the heck did I get my hands on this wine? Well, it's not terribly interesting to be honest but there not a lot I can say about it either. This is one of Spain's larger wine companies and this is their best wine. Trust me – I tasted through the entire portfolio. The wine would retail here for \$85+ a bottle and probably more now with the weak dollar.

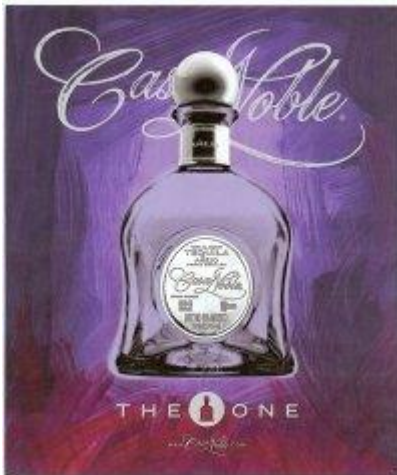
